

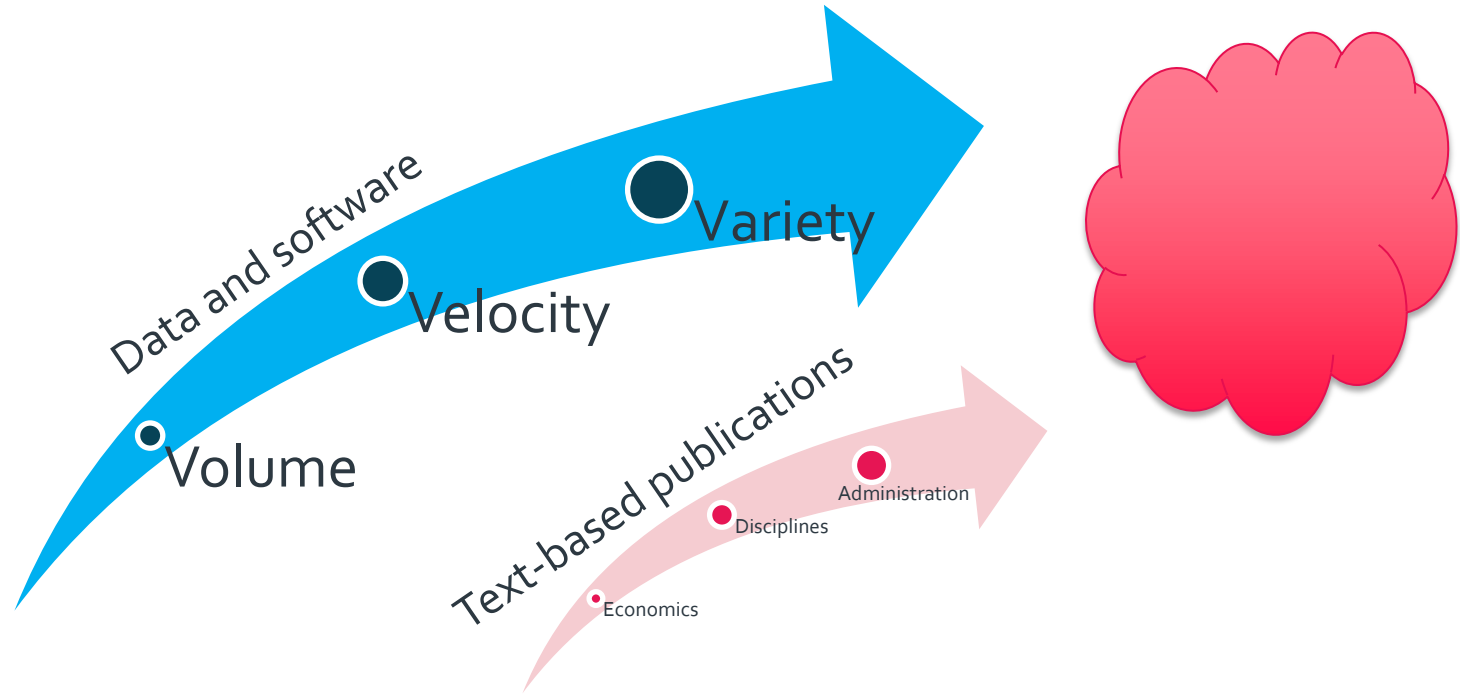

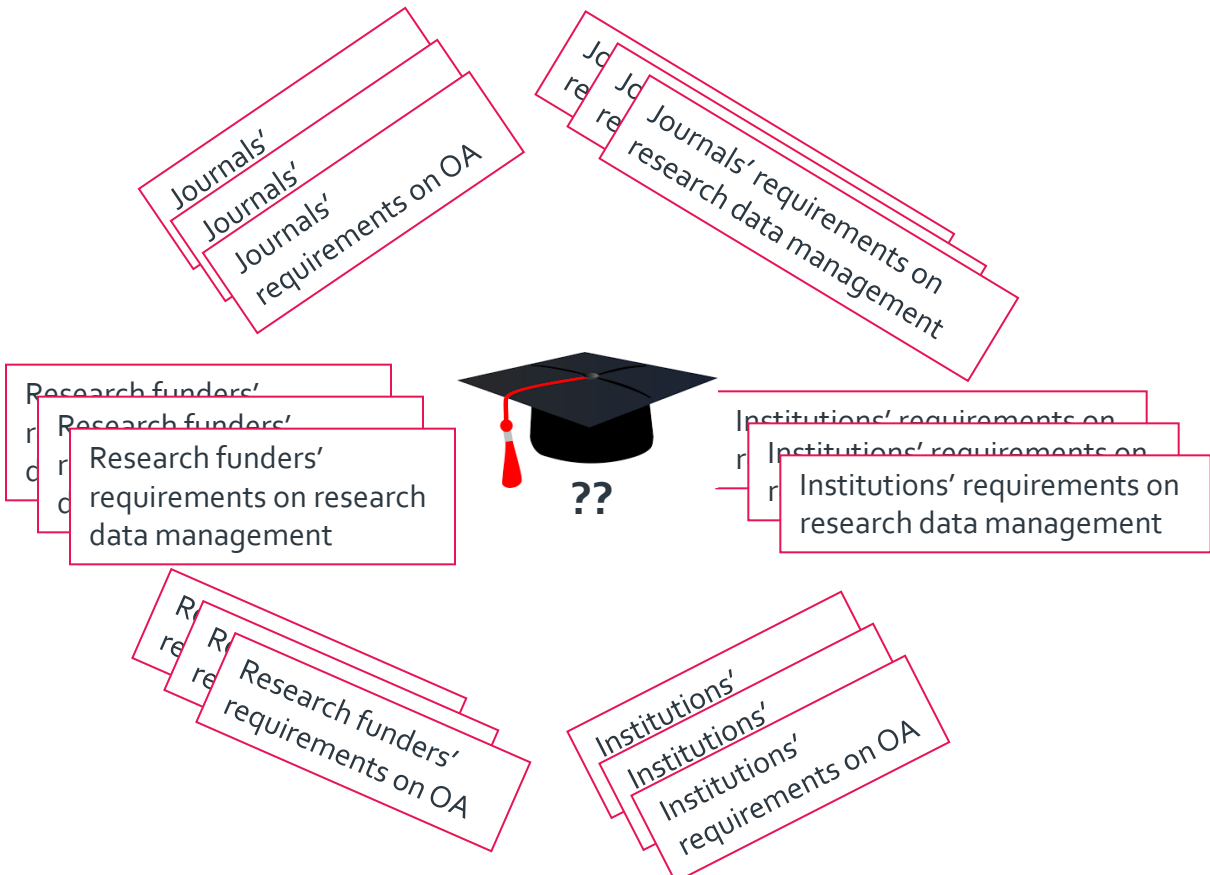

RCUK (£2.3bn p.a.)	Immediate Gold OA, under CC-BY, APC paid, or Embargoed Green OA	No requirement, but encouragement and active consideration
Wellcome Trust (£700m p.a.)	Immediate Gold OA, under CC-BY, APC paid, or Embargoed Green OA	Immediate Gold OA, under CC-BY-NC/D, BPC paid, or Embargoed Green OA
REF (1.6bn p.a.)	Deposit at acceptance (delayed..) Discoverable by publication OA within ~RCUK embargo limits	No requirement this time, but active consideration for future
EC Horizon 2020 (£67bn over six years)	Deposit by publication Immediate Gold OA, APC paid, or Embargoed Green OA	No requirement this time, but encouragement Funding for FP7

Policy	Implementation
RCUK (£2.3bn p.a.)	Block grants to institutions, based on previous grant income, used for APCs + Repositories updated to common metadata format 2015 review: speed, communication, admin, money, licences
Wellcome Trust (£700m p.a.)	Charity OA Fund block grants to 36 institutions Focused on deposit into Europe PubMed Central Increasing concern about the operation of the journals market
REF (1.6bn p.a.)	Applies from 1 April 2016, initially deposit on publication, because of concerns over practicality of “deposit on acceptance” Has prompted the development of new services
EC Horizon 2020 (£67bn over six years)	Information and advice via OpenAIRE NOAD Repository content harvested via UK metadata and aggregation to OpenAIRE Participation in FP7 post-grant OA pilot – some take-up
